TASK DESCRIPTION:

You are to write a 1000 word report discussing how you came to be who you are today.

The objective of this task is to apply the research method of personal reflection to a discussion of the significant influences in your life. For example, an examination of the socialisation processes as they apply to your life. Also make reference to whether these influences are part of your micro, meso or macro worlds.

You must apply fundamental and key concepts to **TWO** social situations, selected from EITHER:

- Your family
- Your school
- Peer or other group to which you belong
- The media

In your response you will also need to reflect on the use of personal reflection as a research method, including an acknowledgement of its problematic nature.
