Task Description:

Compose a 1000 word digital essay that **evaluates** the following question:

How do Henry Lawson's short stories reveal enduring traits of Australian identity and culture?

Your response must discuss 3 of Lawson's Short Stories. Make your selection from:

- 'The Drover's Wife'
- 'The Union Buries Its Dead'
- 'Shooting the Moon'
- 'Our Pipes'
- 'The Loaded Dog'

Your response must adhere to the following digital essay requirements:

- Multi-modal: includes an engaging combination of written text, images, embedded video/sound and hyperlinks.
- Contains a 1000 word extended written response (ie an essay) with a clear thesis statement that addresses the set question. The discussion contains analysis and evaluation.
- Produced using Microsoft Sway, which is available via Office 365.

NB: Consider using the ALARM method to help you craft your extended response.
