TASK DESCRIPTION:

You are to research **ONE** outside factor that affects a mother and the unborn/developing child. The research is to be presented as a poster that could be used in a doctor's surgery or maternity clinic. It must also contain a bibliography on the back/attached.

The outside factors that can be chosen are:

- **Smoking – choose either nicotine, marijuana**
- **Alcohol**
- **Drugs – choose from cocaine, heroin, prescription drugs, ecstasy or ice**
- **Mothers diet - healthy diet for the positive growth and development of an unborn child**

In your research:

1. *Define* the outside factor chosen.
2. *Explain* the impact the chosen factor has on the human body.
3. *Describe* the effects of the chosen factor on a pregnant woman AND baby in regards to mental health, physical health, emotional health and addiction for both the newborn and the mother.
4. Research recent statistics on the chosen factor regarding dependency, adoption and the future of the mother and the newborn.
5. *Discuss* what follow up care / services are available for the mother and newborn for the chosen factor.
6. Mention other interesting facts/ statistics that have been discovered.

Note: You must include a bibliography with your assessment task. Your bibliography is a record of all the sources you used to get information for your entire assessment task. This includes books, website addresses, newspaper articles, information brochures etc.
