 - No phone use.
 - Complete set work.
 - Arrive to school and class on time.
- Cooperate with staff and follow instructions and meet the expectations in learning and classroom behaviour.

Your child has read and accepted that their behaviour needs to be to a high standard. It has been reiterated to them that their behaviour will be monitored and if they are placed on suspension, a head teacher or deputy monitoring cards, have recent truancy or negative incidence on Sentral they will not be considered for selection into representative teams.
