TASK DESCRIPTION:

Part 1:

Research **two** of the following methods used by the Nazi regime to exercise control over the German people:

- laws,
- censorship,
- repression,
- terror,
- propaganda

AND the effect of the *Führerprinzip* (cult of personality).

Write 200 words on each method **analysing** how the Nazis utilised it (600 words total).

Part 2:

Find three primary sources (one for each of the above methods) that demonstrates the effect of each of the factors on everyday life in Nazi Germany
(three sources in total – 1 for *Führerprinzip* and 2 for the two methods you research).

For each source write 200 words that **analyse** and **evaluate** its usefulness and limitations for historians studying life in Nazi Germany (600 words total).

Part 3:

Provide a detailed bibliography referring to a minimum of 6 resources accessed. Your assessment should be presented as a written report (total word limit 1200 words) and may use subheadings.

You will be given ONE class lesson only to work on this task. This will be on MONDAY 19th NOVEMBER. Please ensure you have found and selected your sources by this date so that you can show them to your teacher for suitability.

Your task is to be completed using a word processing program (Google Docs or Microsoft Word). Your assessment task must be submitted on the due date in printed form. Please see your teacher prior to the due date if this is an issue.
