As Picton High School prepares for the innovation campus the Personal, Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE) faculty have had a reduction in practical teaching facilities. This has resulted in the school losing all grassed areas to accommodate the temporary school that will be used whilst the new campus is being built.

To accommodate the practical component of this course, classes will be out of school during various times throughout the week and students will either walk or be transported to the various destinations by bus. All classes will leave from the front of the school (bus bay) at the beginning of their period. The venues the students will be attending are within and Wollondilly Shire and include the Wollondilly Leisure Centre, Picton Oval, Hume Oval and the Picton Botanical Gardens.

The students will be participating in activities that will form a substantial part of their assessment, and all students are required to participate. Students who are un-able to attend offsite practical lessons must bring a note signed by a parent or guardian outlining the reason why and will be required to complete alternative work to meet all outcomes of the course.
