We are writing to let you know of the arrangements for the Year 11 Preliminary Examinations. The examination period is from Thursday, 12th September to Friday, 20th September 2019.

As such, the usual rules apply regarding assessments and examinations. Any student who is unable to attend an examination must notify Student Central or Mr Wilson on the morning of the examination and must comply with the Senior Examination Policy (attached).

Students must be in attendance at school for their scheduled examination. At other times, attendance is not compulsory. Students have received a copy of the Examination Timetable and, if this has been misplaced, it is available on the school's website. Students must wear full school uniform

Students should arrive at least twenty minutes prior to the examination start time and wait near the front of the hall.
