



Picton High School Academic Enrichment Class

Picton High School offers a selective stream of classes designed as an academic extension program for students in Stage 4. The program offers capable students avenues for developing a deeper understanding of key learning area (KLA) content and developing skills in problem solving, critical thinking, leadership and interpersonal communication.

The program also incorporates a focus on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths) & CAPA (Creative and performing Arts) with an extra elective allocation which focuses on practical application of skills across these areas. The programming and assessment are independent of mainstream Year 7 classes, offering teachers the flexibility to extend students and provide inquiry-based learning opportunities across KLA's.

Picton High School has a partnership with University of Western Sydney which has generously offered their facilities to enhance the experience of students in the Enrichment Program. University of Western Sydney offers a rich and stimulating environment for expanding student understanding of the Science, Technology and Engineering.

Selection is through an application and interview/testing process. The application form is available from the Picton High School website.
