TASK DESCRIPTION:

Students will be required to complete a **Paper One** - Area of Study 'Discovery' Trial Exam. This exam has 3 sections: short answer, creative writing and an extended response based on your prescribed text. The exam will be 2 hours with 10 minutes reading time.

Students will also complete a **Paper Two** exam on the first two modules they have studied in class. There will be two extended responses. The exam will be 1.5 hours with 5 minutes reading time.
